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Introduction to Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10

Scanco Multi-Bin includes the experience of 20 years integrated exclusively for Sage 100 ERP. It provides a seamless multi-bin and warehouse management system functionality. It is flexible to setup to get quick startup and simple design, and it can be setup for more advanced needs utilizing WMS features. The built-in Directed Picking and Directed Put-away features provide comprehensive options, so the system directs as you want to. It is compatible with most extended solutions, developer enhancements, and business object integration.

About this Guide





This guide provides the information necessary for installing Scanco Multi-Bin.

Important Information

Read this guide completely before installing Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10.

Before installing Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10, install and register Sage 100 Standard, Sage 100 Advanced or Sage 100 Premium 2018.

Refer to the Sage 100 Installation and System Administrator's Guide for information on installing Sage 100 Standard, Sage 100 Advanced or Sage 100 Premium.

-  **Warning:** Install Multi-Bin Version 2018.10 into a parallel test Sage 100 environment. Performing a test upgrade or a test new install allows you to resolve issues that may occur during the live upgrade or live new install, reducing downtime and allows you to get a rough estimate of how long the upgrade process will take. Refer to the [Sage Knowledgebase article ID 101266](#) for more information. As noted in the Sage Knowledgebase article before step 20, third party products must be re-installed after a migration.
-  **Warning:** Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10 may not be compatible with other Scanco or non-Scanco third party products. If you use third-party products that integrate with your Sage product, check with the vendor of your third-party product to ensure their product is fully compatible with this release. If you integrate with other Sage products, check with your business partner or Sage to ensure that these components are compatible.
-  **Warning:** Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10 may not be installed when Sage Operations Management exists in Sage 100. The Scanco Multi-Bin for Operations Management 6.00.10.0 specific installer must be used.
-  **Warning:** Scanco Manufacturing Efficiency, WOScan, In-Transit, Scheduled Bill of Materials, and Advanced Landed Cost are not currently available for Version 2018.10. If these enhancements are present in Sage 100, upgrade cannot proceed.

Scanco Multi-Bin Pre-Installation Checklist

Complete the following pre-installation checklist prior to installing Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10 to ensure a successful installation.

- ❑ Do **not** install Scanco Multi-Bin when custom modifications exist in Sage. Custom modifications must be retrofitted to the current Sage 100 version. Please contact your Sage partner or your Scanco Account Rep for information on how to obtain a quote for custom modifications to be retrofitted to Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10.
- ❑ Do **not** install Scanco Multi-Bin when extended solutions or third-party products are installed on the Sage 100 system. Please contact your Sage partner or your Scanco Account Rep for information on evaluating extended solutions or third-party software.
- ❑ Do **not** install Scanco Multi-Bin when Sage Operations Management 6.00.10.0 is installed in Sage 100 Version 2018.10. The Scanco Multi-Bin for Operations Management 6.00.10.0 specific installer must be used.
- ❑ Confirm that the Sage 100 installed version is 6.00.10.0 for the Sage 100 Standard, Sage 100 Advanced or Sage 100 Premium system.
Access the Help menu > About Sage to review the currently installed Sage 100 version.
To review additional information on the currently installed Sage 100 system in the Sage 100 System Information window, select File menu > Run. Type *info in the Program field. Select the OK button.
- ❑ Confirm that Scanco Manufacturing Efficiency, WOScan, In-Transit, Scheduled Bill of Materials, and/or Advanced Landed Cost are not present. If it is necessary to uninstall any of these modules, contact Scanco Support at support@scanco.com.
- ❑ Prior to installation or upgrade, ensure that the following transactions have been updated
 - Inventory Transactions
 - Sales Order Invoices
 - Sales Order Shipping Data Entries
 - Purchase Order Receipt of Goods
 - Purchase Order Return of Goods
 - RMA Returns
 - Bill of Materials Production Entries
- ❑ Backup the entire Sage 100 Standard, Sage 100 Advanced or Sage 100 Premium system, including programs and data files, after all data entry files are updated, and before installing Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2020.
- ❑ Download the Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10 installation file and request registration information from <http://info.scanco.com/scanco-multibin-downloads>
Please note that it can take 3-5 business days to receive Registration Keys. If Custom Modifications are found, registration files will be delayed and a Scanco Account Rep will be in contact to evaluate an upgrade.

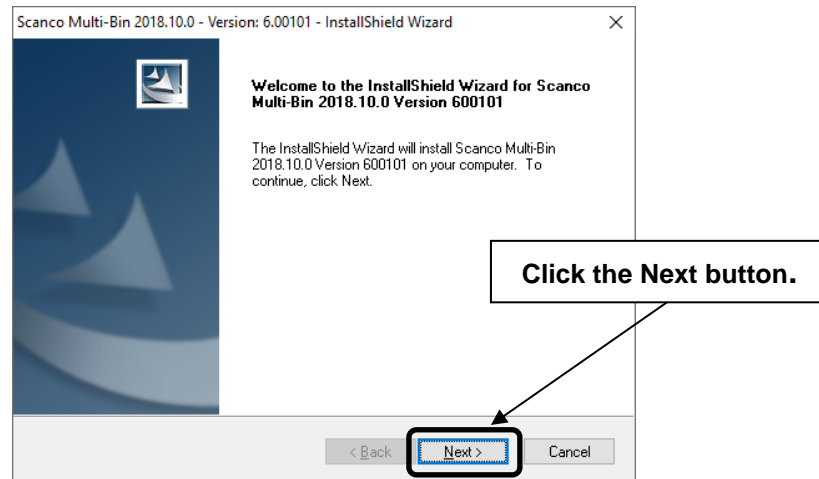

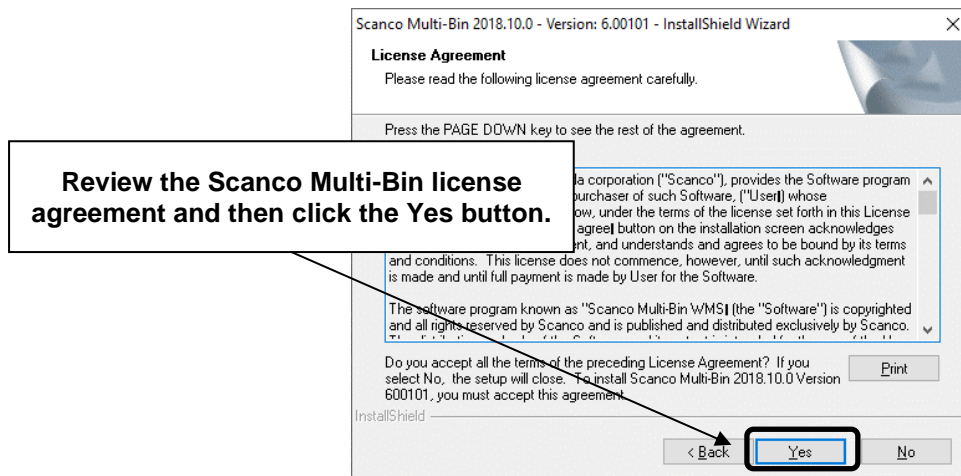

How to Install Scanco Multi-Bin

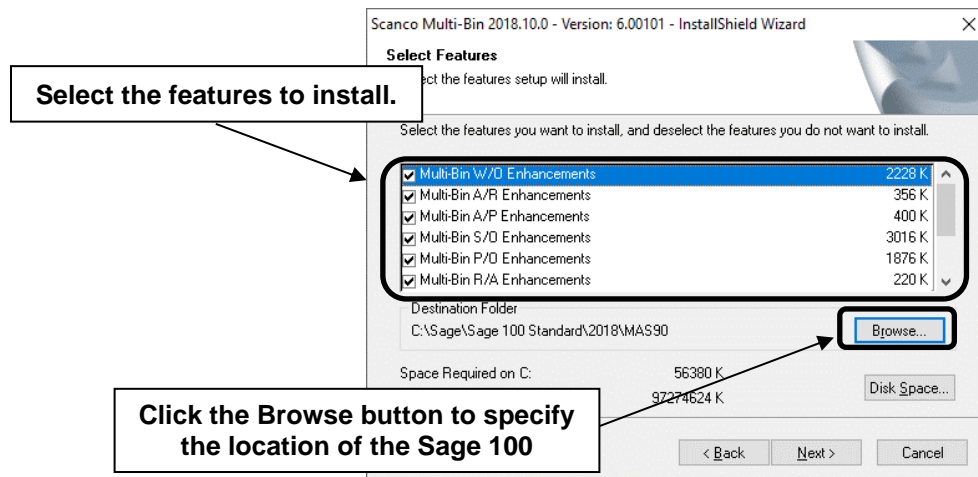
1. Download the MB600101.exe file from the Scanco Multi-Bin Downloads page at <https://www.scanco.com/scanco-multibin-downloads>
2. Right click on the Scanco Multi-Bin 2018.10 (600101) executable file.
3. Select Run as administrator.



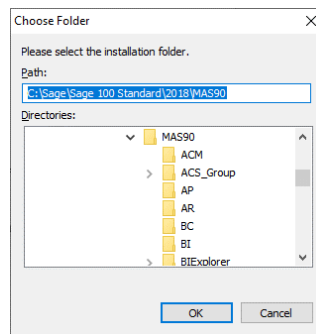
4. Select the Next button from the Scanco Multi-Bin 2018.10 (600101) Welcome window.
5. Review the Scanco Multi-Bin 2018.10 (600101) License Agreement.



6. Select the Yes button to agree to the Scanco Multi-Bin License Agreement and to continue with the installation process.
7. Accept the default check box field settings for Scanco Multi-Bin 2018.10 600101.



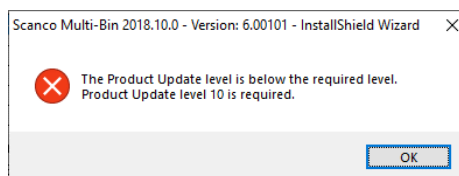
- Accept the default location of Sage 100 or select the Browse button to specify the location of Sage 100. The Choose Folder window displays after the Browse button is selected.



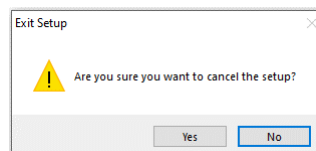
Specify the location of Sage 100 in the Path field. Select the OK button to return to the Select Features window.

- Select the Next button from the Select Features window. The installed version of Sage 100 Standard, Sage 100 Advanced or Sage 100 Premium is validated.

When Sage 100 2018 version 6.00.10.0. has not been installed at the specified Sage 100 location, the following message displays.



Select the OK button from the message. Select the Cancel button from the Select Features window. The following Exit Setup message displays.



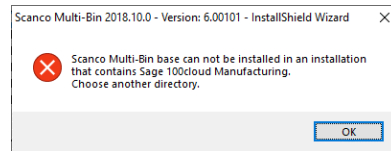
Select Yes in the Exit Setup message.

Select the Finish button from the InstallShield Wizard Complete window to cancel the Scanco Multi-Bin 6.00.10.0 installation process.



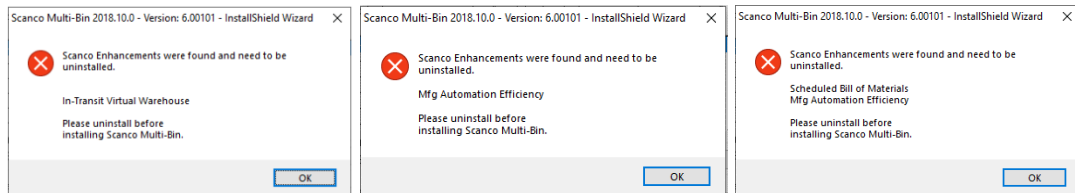
To resolve, install Sage 100 2020 and then install Scanco Multi-Bin 2018 600101.

Warning: Scanco Multi-Bin Version 2018.10 may not be installed when Sage Operations Management exists in Sage 100. The Scanco Multi-Bin for Operations Management 6.00.10.0 specific installer must be used.

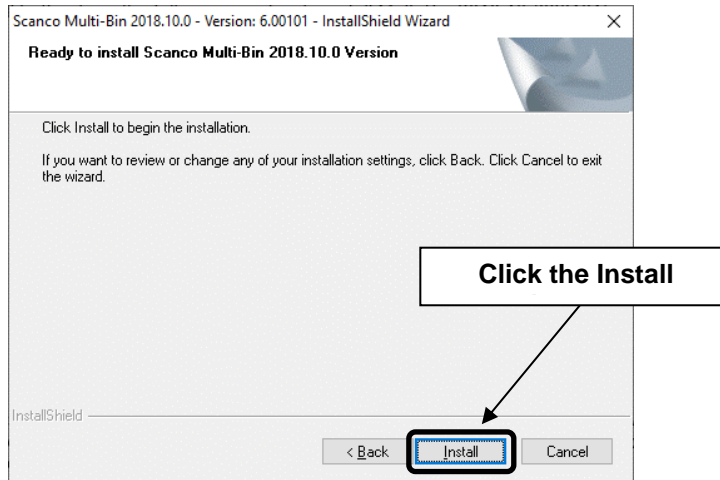


Select OK and cancel the Multi-Bin 2018.10 (600101) installation process. Download the MB600101_OM.exe file from <http://portal.jobops.com>.

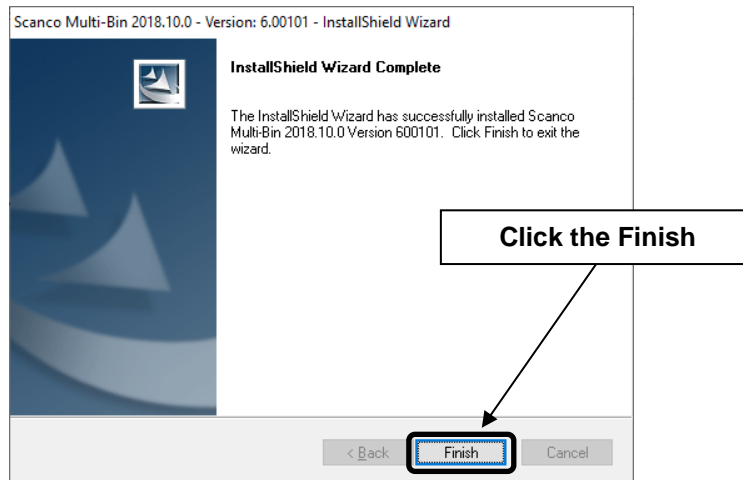
10. Select the Install button from the following window to install Multi-Bin 2018.10 (600101).



Select the Back button to return to the Select Features window.

Select the Cancel button, then select Yes in the message *Are you sure you want to cancel the setup?* and the Finish button from the InstallShield Wizard Complete window to cancel the Scanco Multi-Bin installation process.

11. Select the Finish button from the InstallShield Wizard Complete window to complete the Scanco Multi-Bin 2018.10 (600101) installation process.



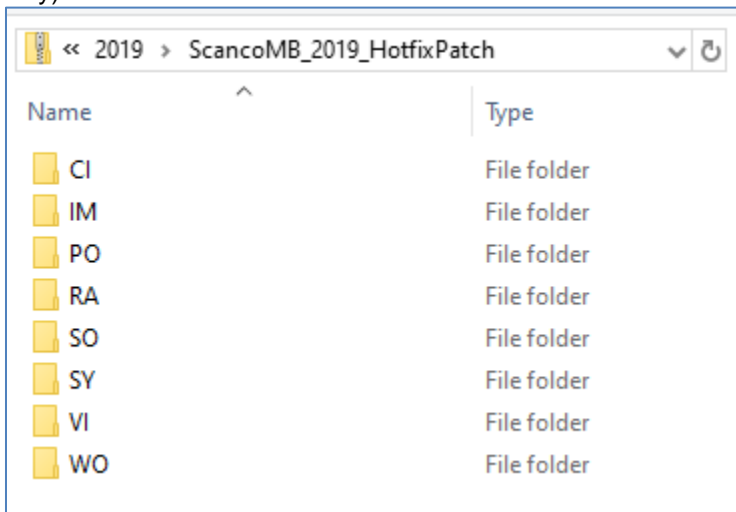
How to Install Scanco Multi-Bin Hot Fixes

If hot fixes are available on the Scanco Multi-Bin Downloads Page for 2018.10, download and install them.

1. Navigate to the Scanco Multi-Bin downloads page at : <https://www.scanco.com/scanco-multibin-downloads>
2. Locate the section for Scanco Multi-Bin 2018.10 Hot fixes. Hot fixes maybe available as singular IDs or in compilation zip files.

⚠ Warning : Hot fixes are Version and Product Update Specific. Please verify that the Sage 100 2018 and Scanco Multi-Bin 2018.10 (600101) version matches the hot fix you are attempting to download and install

3. Hot fixes will download in .zip format. Extract the zipped directories into a working area.
4. Within the zip will be program directories that directly correspond to directories found within the Sage 100 /MAS90 directory. (The example below is a 2019 Hot Fix Patch File for demonstration purposes only).




5. Prior to installing Scanco Multi-Bin 2018 Hotfixes, retain a backup of all /MAS90 directory programs.
6. Copy the contents of each directory of the zip file to the corresponding directory of /MAS90

How to Obtain Scanco Multi-Bin Registration

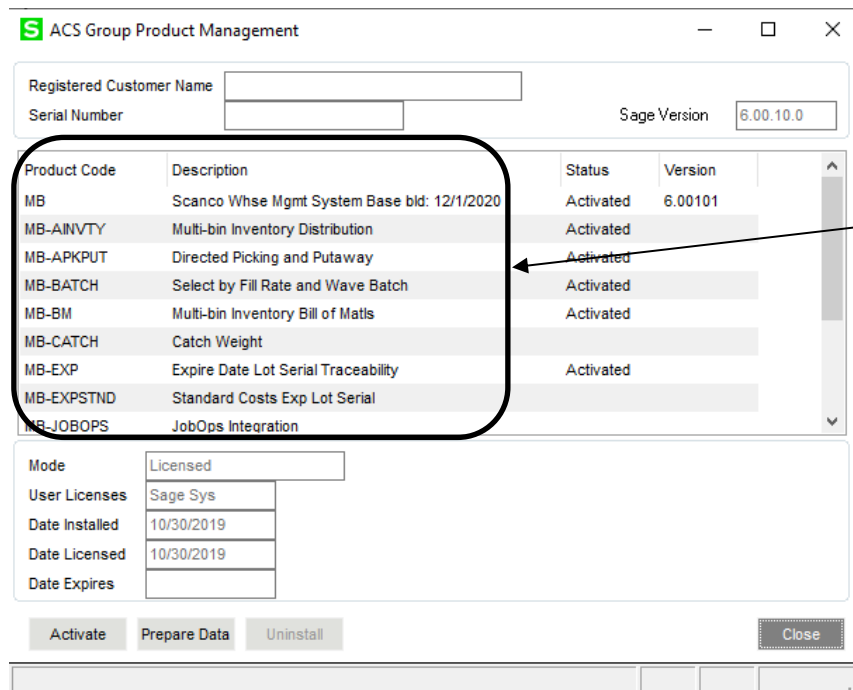
1. Navigate to the Scanco Multi-Bin downloads page at : <https://www.scanco.com/scanco-multibin-downloads>
2. Scroll down and click on Registration File Request.
3. Enter the required information in the Scanco Multi-Bin Registration form. Fields noted with an asterisk (*) are required.
4. Select the Submit button.

 **Note:** Please allow 3-5 business days for processing Scanco Multi-Bin registration requests. If Custom Modifications are found, registration files will be delayed and a Scanco Account Rep will be in contact. The Scanco Multi-Bin registration file is sent to the email specified in the Primary Contact Email field on the Scanco Multi-Bin Registration form.

Internet Activation

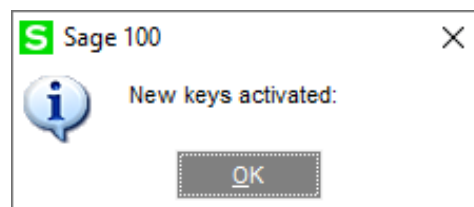
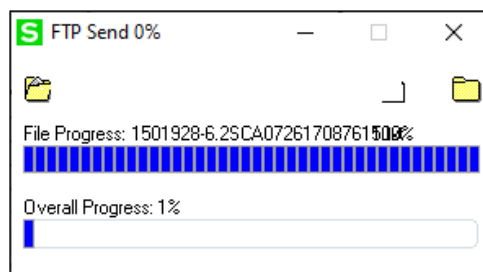
1. Access Library Master > Setup > ACS Group Product Registration.

This screen will list the Sage System's Registered Custom Name, Sage issue Serial Number, and the Current Sage Version installed.

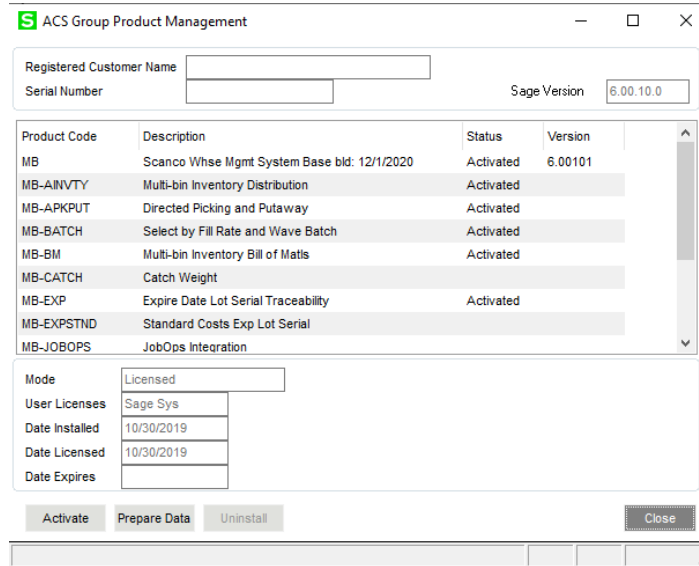

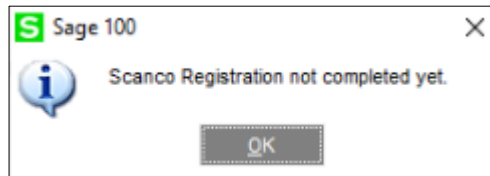
2. Select the Activate button.
3. The system will attempt to locate your Activation Key file from the Scanco FTP.
4. If found, the program will automatically install the key and activate modules.



- After keys are installed, Mode will show Licensed and individual enhancements will show Activated based on purchase.

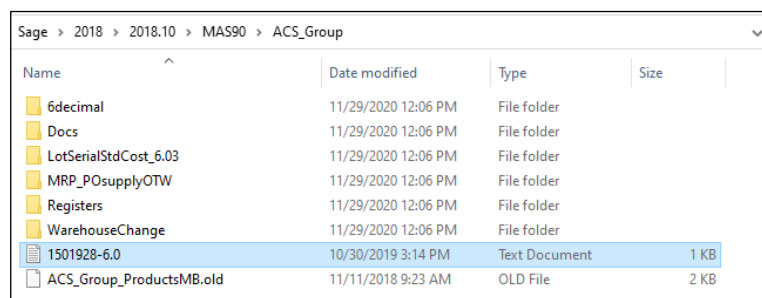

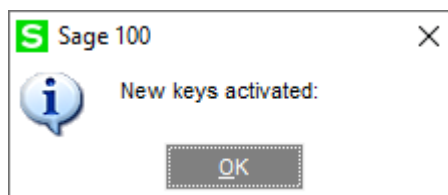


Manual Activation

- When requesting Scanco Multi-Bin keys, a text Activation Key File with the format "SageSerialNumber-Version.txt" is provided.
- If Internet Activation is not successful, copy the text Activation Key File to /MAS90/ACS_Group.



- Access Library Master > Setup > ACS Group Product Registration.
- Select the Activate button.
- The system will activate keys.



Data Preparation and Conversion

Sage Data Conversion Utility

After Scanco Multi-Bin Installation, the Sage Data Conversion Utility must be completed.

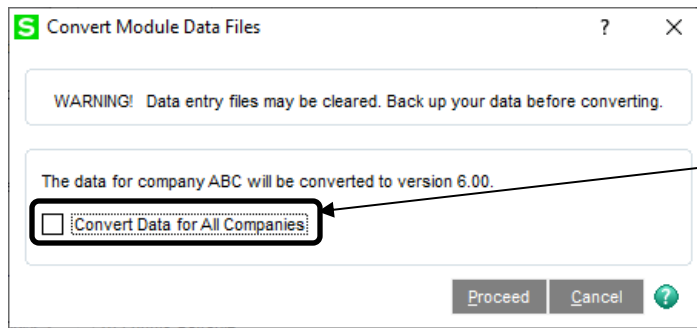
- In new Scanco Multi-Bin Installations, this will ensure that all Sage required updates, conversion, or Product Update Changes are fully integrated. Users will be *required* to complete the Sage Data Conversion Utility prior to accessing any module activities.
- In Scanco Multi-Bin Upgrades, this will ensure that all Sage data conversion activities are successfully completed. Users will be *required* to complete the Sage Data Conversion Utility prior to accessing any module activities.

To Run the Sage Data Conversion Utility:

1. Users should be out of the system prior to running the Sage Data Conversion Utility.
2. Navigate to Library Master > Main > Company Maintenance.
3. Select a Company Code to Convert.

4. Select the Convert Button.
5. In the Convert Module Data Files Screen, review the warning and click Proceed when ready.



To save time, Sage provides a checkbox that allow all Company Data to be converted at once. Users should be out of the system for this process.

6. The utility will convert data in each company as needed.
7. If no conversions are necessary, a prompt will appear. Click OK to finish.



Scanco Multi-Bin Prepare Data Utility

After Installation is complete and the Sage Data Conversion Utility has been completed, the Scanco Multi-Bin Prepare Data Utility must be completed.

The Prepare Data Utility is a multi-function utility that completes data file preparation for new users and data conversion for existing users. Whenever an installation of Scanco Multi-Bin is completed, the prepare data utility should be completed.

Warning : Users must exit Sage 100 in order for the Prepare Data Utility to function properly

New Users

Prior to enabling Scanco Multi-Bin for any company, the Prepare Data Utility must be run in order to prepare existing data files with new Scanco Multi-Bin Fields and new create Scanco Multi-Bin Files where needed.

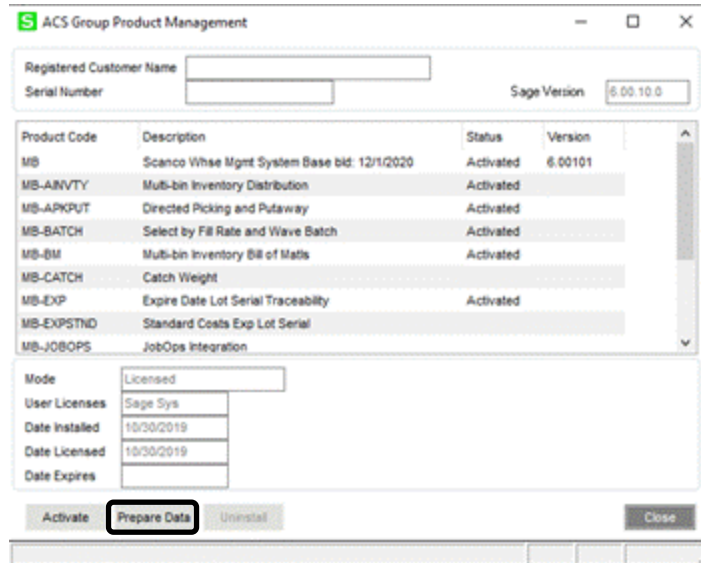
Part of the Scanco Multi-Bin Prepare Data Utility process is the merge of Scanco's new files and fields into Sage's system wide Data Dictionary. Because data dictionary definition is system-wide – the prepare Data utility must be run for ALL companies in the Sage 100 system, even if it will not use Scanco Multi-Bin. This will ensure that all Sage 100 features which rely on the data dictionary – like custom reporting – will continue to function properly. Running the prepare data utility for a given company WILL NOT enable Multi-Bin in that company.

Conversion

When Converting Sage 100 and Scanco Multi-Bin to a new Version, the Prepare Data Utility also functions as a data conversion utility. The utility will ensure that all new files and fields are properly setup and that data is converted from the prior version properly.

To Run the Scanco Multi-Bin Prepare Data Utility:

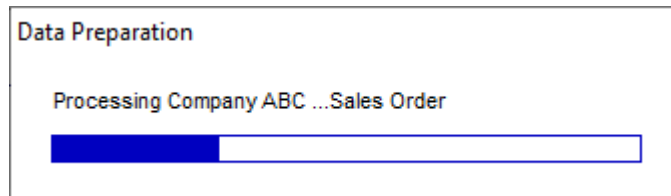
1. Users should be out of the system prior to running the Scanco Multi-Bin Prepare Data Utility.
2. Navigate to Library Master > Setup > ACS Group Product Registration
3. Click the Prepare Data Button.



4. A prompt allows users to select to run the Prepare Data Utility for one company (current company), all companies (recommended), or no companies (cancel).



5. A Processing Screen will appear to track the progress of the Prepare Data Utility through each module, in each company. There are several Multi-Bin utilities that will also run at the end of the utility.



Warning : The time necessary to run the Prepare Data Utility is dependent on Sage 100 database size and server performance. Please know that the Prepare Data Utility can run anywhere as quickly as a few minutes to several hours. Prepare for downtime accordingly, as users must be out of the system for the duration of the utility.

6. On completion, the Processing Screen will clear and the user is returned to the Scanco Product Management Screen.

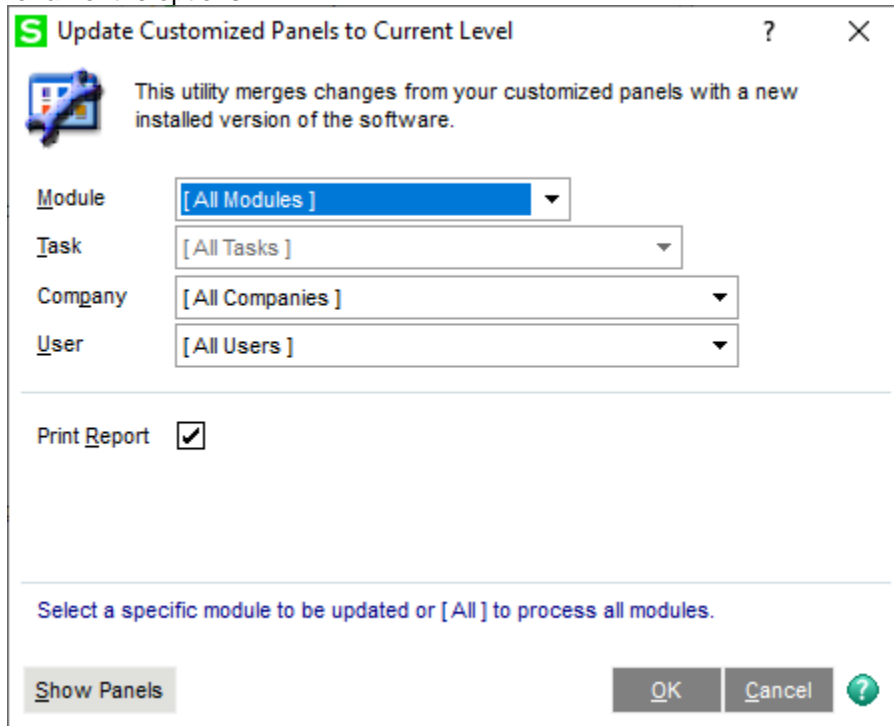
Update Custom Panels to Current Level

Once Scanco Multi-Bin has been installed, it is prudent to merge existing screen customizations with the screen modifications that Scanco Multi-Bin provides. Sage provides the Custom Office Update Custom Panels to Current Level utility to accomplish this.

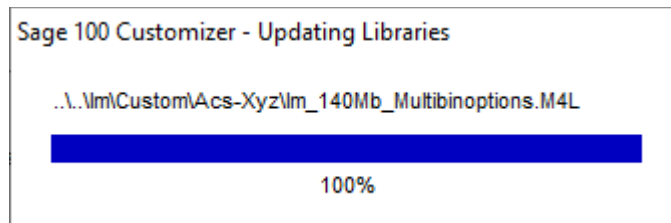
Warning : In some cases, customizations must be merged manually. Please contact your Sage partner or Scanco Support at support@scanco.com for assistance.

To merge custom panels:

1. Navigate to Custom Office > Utilities > Update Custom Panels to Current Level
2. While specific Module, Task, Company, and User selections can be made, it is advised to run this utility for **all** of the options.



3. Select the OK button.
4. The system will display a process bar displaying the screen libraries being updated.



5. After update, if the "Print Report" option was selected, the user will be prompted to Print or Preview the Custom Office Customizer Detail Report. This is not required and can be skipped.
